HEALTH ORDER – NEW ARRIVALS

Welcome to Niue – as a country that continues to closely monitor and manage COVID-19. We look forward to your cooperation to keep it that way.

Pursuant to Section 14 of the Public Health Act 1965, you have been classified as a “suspected person” of a “notifiable disease” and are therefore required to comply with these health orders issued by the Director of Health, Dr. Edgar Akau’ola:

- For the first three days, until you’ve received a negative Day 3 test result, **you must wear a well-fitting mask at all times when in indoor public places** and avoid contact with the elderly, pregnant, and others you know who have medical conditions.
- On **Day 1 (Saturday)** please undertake a self-administered Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) at your place of accommodation. Please report the results to covid.results@gov.nu or via Facebook messenger to <https://www.facebook.com/niuepublichealth>.
- On **Day 3 (Monday)**, you are required to have a PCR test at Niue Ffoo* Hospital.
 - o Please report to the Drive-Thru COVID-19 Testing Station near the Niue Ffoo Hospital (please follow signs).
 - o Your testing should be completed between 9am and 12pm, and you may come in the vehicle with those you travelled with.
 - o Remain in your vehicle, do not lower your mask until requested, and comply with all testing requirements.
- Both tests must be upheld to ensure early detection of any positive cases. Only children under 3 years and are exempt from the testing requirements.

Failure to comply with any of these orders is an offence and you will be liable to prosecution.
